HB 2505

Directs Governor's Child Foster Care Advisory Commission to establish Child Welfare Equity Advisory Committee to advise the commission and Department of Human Services regarding equitable provision of child welfare services.

HB 2465 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Foster Parent Ombudsman in Department of Human Services and prescribes duties.

HB 2104 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Modifies definition of "current caretaker."

Grants juvenile court continuing wardship jurisdiction upon establishment of permanent or durable guardianship regardless of whether original bases for wardship jurisdiction continue to exist.

HB 2340 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to Department of Human Services for transition services for current foster children and former foster children.
