### Public Hearing

SB 109

(1:05-1:35 pm) Directs State Parks and Recreation Commission to adopt rules managing use of unmanned aircraft systems by people in state parks.

SB 315

(1:35 pm - 2:00 pm) Exempts from required disclosure business, commercial, financial, operational and research data and information that is furnished, developed or generated in connection with ownership or operation of unmanned aerial system test range, if disclosure of information would cause competitive disadvantage to test range or users.
