SB 298

SB 190 A

(1:20 - 1:35 pm) Modifies permissible methods of providing notice of appointment of guardian to protected person.

SB 572

(1:35 - 1:55 pm) Modifies protective proceedings to permit vulnerable youth guardianships for adults between 18 and 21 years of age who are eligible for special immigrant status and who are unable to be reunified with parent due to abuse, neglect or abandonment that occurred before adult attained 18 years of age.
