**Work Session**

HB 2930

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/17/2021 MEETING: Imposes limitations on arbitrators' decisions concerning alleged misconduct by law enforcement officers.

HB 3047

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/17/2021 MEETING: Establishes civil cause of action for improper disclosure of personal information.

HB 3145

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/17/2021 MEETING: Directs Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to establish publicly available database of certain information about misconduct and discipline of public safety employees established by department.

HB 3273

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/17/2021 MEETING: Prohibits law enforcement agency from releasing booking photo except in specified circumstances.

HB 2929

Modifies police officer's duty to report misconduct.

**March 22, 2021**

HB 2162

Directs Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to study changes to police officer training and to provide results of study to Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2021.
