Work Session

HB 2434

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to report to Legislative Assembly no later than February 15, 2022, on options for revenue system reform including recommendations for legislation intended to reform current system for raising revenue.

SB 141 A

Makes percentage of partial property tax exemption for property of vertical housing development projects proportional to allocation of floor area to residential housing or low income residential housing, without rounding up or down.

HB 2070

(Carried over from 6-7-2021 meeting) Extends privilege taxes on merchantable forest products harvested on forestlands.

HB 2456

(Carried over from 6-7-2021 meeting) Makes corrections to and updates tax statutes.

HB 2438

(Carried over from 6-7-2021 meeting) Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to study property tax reform and report findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to revenue no later than September 15, 2022.
