HB 3219

(7:15 pm) Requires local governments to approve reconstruction of manufactured dwelling parks after wildfire.

HB 2809

(7:35 pm) Allows temporary siting for up to 24 months of recreational vehicles on properties with dwellings that natural disasters have made uninhabitable.
