HB 2290 \*\*

(8:00 am) Requires State Parks and Recreation Department to develop, implement and periodically update plan for installation and service of public electric vehicle charging stations in parking spaces that are part of facilities of state park system.

SB 106

(8:15 am) Requires Class IV all-terrain vehicle operator 16 years of age or older to carry and present both driver license and all-terrain vehicle operator permit.

SB 107

(8:30 am) Modifies definition of "Class IV all-terrain vehicle." Removes requirement that certain off-road vehicles be equipped with windshield wipers.

HB 2137

(8:45 am) Modifies, adds and repeals laws related to transportation.
