#### Public Hearing

HB 3244

Increases maximum amount of tax credits for certified film production development contributions that may be certified for fiscal year for all taxpayers.

SB 43

Extends sunsets for labor rebate for qualifying film production and tax credit for certified film production development contributions.

HB 2096 B

Increases maximum agriculture workforce housing tax credits issued by Housing and Community Services Department to \$16.75 million per biennium.

HB 2584 B

Increases total amount of tax credits for affordable housing lenders allowed for all taxpayers per fiscal year.
