SB 14

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-23-2021 MEETING: Establishes product stewardship program for plastic packaging and plastic food serviceware.

SB 581

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-23-2021 MEETING: Prohibits sale of products that make deceptive or misleading claims about recyclability.

SB 582

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-23-2021 MEETING: Directs Department of Environmental Quality to study and make recommendations for modernizing Oregon's recycling system and provide results of study in report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022.

Urges Congress to enact bipartisan climate change legislation.
