SB 141

**CARRIED OVER FROM 03-04-2021 MEETING:** Makes percentage of partial property tax exemption for property of vertical housing development projects proportional to allocation of equalized floors to residential housing or low income residential housing, without rounding up or down.

#### Public Hearing

SB 108

Makes changes to program for property tax special assessment of historic property.

SB 482

Requires personal income taxpayer to add to federal taxable income amount of federal tax savings resulting from investment services partnership income being treated as net capital gain and taxed at lower rate on personal income taxpayer's federal return.
