Work Session

HB 2446

Extends sunset of property tax exemption for property of nonprofit corporation offered, occupied or used as low-income housing.

HB 2457 A

Updates connection date to federal Internal Revenue Code and other provisions of federal tax law.

HB 2008 B

Provides tax exemption for property of religious organization held or used solely to provide affordable housing to low income households.

SB 139

Reduces amount of income eligible for elective reduced personal income tax rate allowed for certain pass-through income.

SB 864

Increases maximum percentage of tax that governing body of city or county may impose on sale of marijuana items.

Public Hearing

HB 2331 A

Excludes from meaning of "communication," for purposes of central assessment for property taxation, services of television and radio stations licensed by Federal Communications Commission that use primarily earth-based transmitters to broadcast programming via radio waves to television or radio receivers that use indoor or outdoor antennas for reception.
