HB 2046 A

Requires insurer to provide specified notice to insured or prospective insured enrolled in short term health insurance policy.

HB 2648

Allows pharmacist or pharmacy technician to transfer drug containing pseudoephedrine without prescription to person who is at least 18 years of age and presents person's valid government-issued photo identification.

HB 3036 A

Allows physician assistant to register with Oregon Medical Board for authority to dispense prescription drugs.
