HB 2364 A

Amends requirements and deadlines for sales of manufactured dwelling facilities.

Instructions on how to submit written testimony and how to register to testify appear at the bottom of the agenda.

HB 2736 A

Requires landlords to provide tenants with informational notice developed by Bureau of Labor and Industries regarding discrimination upon execution of rental agreement on or after January 1, 2022, or for existing rental agreements by February 1, 2022.

HB 2484 A

Requires landlord to allow dwelling to be used as family child care home.

HB 3322 A

Allows production of food in planned community by lot owners and their tenants.

HB 3113 A

Limits exemption from rent increase limits for landlords renting under government programs reducing rents.

HB 3124 A

Increases time that written notice must be posted before removal of homeless individuals from established camping site.

HB 2415 A

Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt rules to establish minimum standards and statewide consistency in electronic processes for reviewing plans, issuing permits and performing field inspections.
