- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. (1) The Public Drinking Water and Sewer Ratepayer
- 5 Assistance Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate and
- 6 distinct from the General Fund. The Public Drinking Water and Sewer
- 7 Ratepayer Assistance Fund shall consist of all moneys placed in the
- 8 fund as provided by law and any gifts, grants, donations, endowments
- 9 or bequests from any public or private source.
  - (2) Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated the Housing and Community Services Department for the purposes set forth in subsection (3) of this section.
- 13 (3) The department shall provide grants from moneys deposited in 14 the fund to qualified organizations to distribute water and sewer bill 15 payment assistance to low-income residential households.
- 16 (4) Qualified organizations for receiving grants under this section 17 shall include, but need not be limited to:
  - (a) Nonprofit community-based organizations, including but not limited to housing authorities and community action agencies; and
    - (b) Municipal utilities providing domestic water or sewer service.

(5) The department shall adopt rules necessary for the administration and implementation of subsections (3) and (4) of this section. In adopting rules, the department shall consider other utility bill payment or crisis assistance and low-income assistance programs administered by the department, including but not limited to the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Act of 1981 (42 U.S.C. 8621 et seq.).

SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services

Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$15 million, for deposit in the Public Drink-

ing Water and Sewer Ratepayer Assistance Fund established under

12 section 1 of this 2021 Act.
