## **SUMMARY**

Appropriates moneys to Department of Environmental Quality to award grant for on-site septic system low-interest loan programs and to cover related administrative costs.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to on-site septic system financing; and declaring an emergency.
- Whereas in 2016 the Legislative Assembly enacted ORS 454.779, which
- 4 directs the Department of Environmental Quality to award grants for devel-
- 5 oping and administering loan programs to provide low-interest loans for the
- 6 repair, replacement, upgrade or evaluation of residential or small business
- 7 on-site septic systems; and
- 8 Whereas since 2016, the Clean Water Loan program funded by a grant
- 9 from the department under ORS 454.779 has served over 186 families, 104
- 10 communities and 35 counties, financing projects that are now treating an
- 11 estimated total of 24 million gallons of wastewater annually; and
- Whereas most commercial banks have stopped or greatly reduced issuing
- 13 second mortgage loans; and
- 14 Whereas nearly one out of every three families served by the Clean Water
- 15 Loan program has a family income that falls below 80 percent of the county's
- 16 area median income, and most borrowers use the program because they
- 17 struggle to obtain a conventional loan; and
- Whereas demand remains high for low-interest loans for the repair, re-
- 19 placement, upgrade or evaluation of residential or small business on-site
- 20 septic systems; and

1 Whereas the COVID-19 pandemic has increased the need for septic repairs; and 2 Whereas the program helps people and families in emergency situations, 3 thereby promoting community resilience, housing stabilization and water quality generally, including during extreme events of fire, flood, pandemic 5 or other natural or human-made disasters; and 6 7 Whereas in July 2020 the program was temporarily suspended for lack of available loan funds; and 8 Whereas the department estimates that over 45,000 septic systems fail 9 each year; now, therefore, 10 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 11 12 SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Environmental 13 Quality, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General 14 Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000 for the purposes of: 15 (1) Not later than September 1, 2021, awarding a grant under ORS 16 454.779 in an amount of not less than \$1,950,000; and 17 (2) Covering administrative costs necessary to implement ORS 18 454.779. 19 SECTION 2. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-20

ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-

clared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect on its passage.
