

## **SB 55 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY**

#### **WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Requires Office of School Facilities to administer a statewide facilities assessment program. Reduces the amount of funding allocated to facility grants from the State School Fund from \$7 million to \$3 million. Increases the amount of money from the State School Fund allocated to the Department of Education for expenses for the Office of School Facilities from \$6 million to \$10 million. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

*REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.*

*FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.*

#### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

#### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Office of School Facilities (OSF) was established in 2015 with passage of Senate Bill 447. The OSF is responsible for maintaining a statewide school facilities database, distributing grants to districts, providing technical assistance, and assisting with the prioritization of capital improvements. Senate Bill 55 adds a statewide facilities assessment program to OSF's responsibilities, increases its administrative funding by \$4 million, and decreases the amount allocated to facility grants by \$4 million.
