WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Allows the possession or delivery of not more than two ounces of usable marijuana by persons 21 years of age and older in a public place. Directs the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to adopt rules in accordance with possession limits. Takes effect 91st day following adjournment sine die.

BACKGROUND:

House Bill 2973 amends statute to allow persons 21 years of age and older to deliver or possess up to two ounces of usable marijuana in a public place, and directs the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to adopt rules in accordance with these possession limits.
