Consolidates unpaid child support accruing under superseded child support order into amounts payable under later-issued court order.

15	(b) The administrator is providing services under ORS 25.080;

19	(d) All parties had an opportunity to challenge the amount of child sup-

purposes of reconciling any support payment records under the two child
 support judgments described in subsection (2) of this section:

(a) The terms of the child support judgment originating under ORS 25.529
are deemed terminated on the effective date of the later-issued child support
judgment; and

6 (b) Entry of the later-issued child support judgment does not affect **the** 7 **amount of** any support payment arrearage or credit that has accrued under 8 the earlier-issued child support judgment originating under ORS 25.529.

9 (4) Any arrearage that accrued under a judgment that is terminated 10 as provided in subsection (2) of this section or that is explicitly ter-11 minated by any other later-issued court judgment is subsumed by the 12 later-issued court judgment and is enforceable in the court case in 13 which the later-issued court judgment was entered.
