WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Eliminates provision providing for automatic imposition of monthly supervision fees for supervision by community corrections program.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Currently, under ORS 423.570, a person sentenced to probation or placed by an authority on parole, post-prison supervision or other form of release, subject to supervision by a community corrections shall be required to pay a monthly fee to offset costs of supervising the probation, parole, post-prison supervision or other supervised release. Timely payment of the fee is made a condition of such probation, parole, post-prison supervision or other supervision or other supervised release.

SB 620 eliminates the automatic imposition of supervision fees as a condition of probationary sentence or supervision.
