- Forest Education Council advises College on best use of Harvest Tax funds.



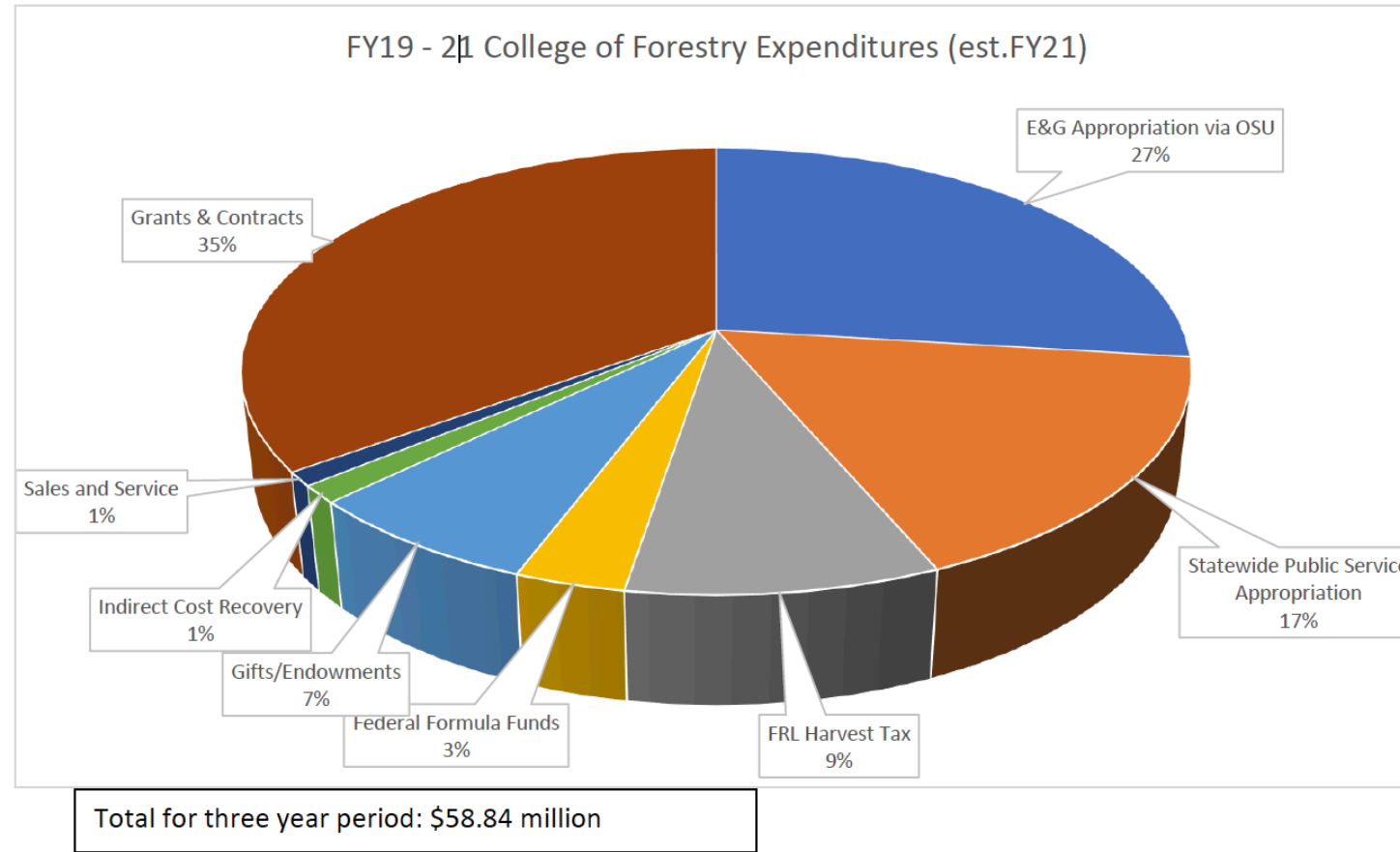
Funding Critical

Secure Substantial Matching Funds

- In the current biennium, Forest Research Lab funding appropriated by the Legislature has been matched at a ratio of nearly 2 to 1, with Harvest Tax dollars supporting all aspects of our work.
