Subject: Senate Confirmation for Business Oregon Director

The Community Chamber Coalition of Oregon supports the recommendation to confirm Sophorn Cheang's appointment as Director of Business Oregon. We agree with Governor Brown that Ms. Cheang will bring a strong competency to 'lead the state agency towards an inclusive economy that will promote Oregon as a competitive, diverse and inclusive economy.'
