WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires that no later than 72 hours after a pretrial detainee is booked into a local correctional facility, staff of the facility shall contact the detainee's primary health care provider (PCP), as identified by the detainee. If the detainee is enrolled in a coordinated care organization or prepaid managed care health services organization, requires staff to contact the appropriate organization to determine the PCP. Requires facility to ensure the detainee receives all treatment prescribed by the detainee's PCP. Requires the Oregon Health Authority to reimburse cities and counties for the cost of providing medication-assisted treatment and substance-use disorder treatment to detainees who do not have other coverage.
