# STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the State Board of Forestry subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

## **Appointees**

Karla Chambers of Corvallis; New Appointment Benjamin Duemling of Springfield; New Appointment Chandra Ferrari of Salem; New Appointment

## Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

## **Statutory Requirements**<sup>3</sup>

The board consists of seven members appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate.<sup>4</sup> The Governor must appoint at least one member from each of the state's three forest regions:

- Eastern Oregon Region (JUSTICE; KELLY);
- Northwest Oregon Region (CHAMBERS, DUEMLING; FERRARI; MCCOMB); and
- Southwest Oregon Region (ROSE).

No more than three members of the board may derive any significant portion of their income directly from persons or organizations that are subject to regulation under the Oregon Forest

Practices Act, and no member of the board may have any relationship or pecuniary interest that would interfere with the member representing the public interest.

Members serve four-year terms and may be removed by the Governor for cause. No member may serve more than two consecutive full terms. The Governor must designate one member of the board as chairperson with such powers and duties as are provided by the rules of the board. The board meets on the first Wednesday after the first Monday in January, March, June and September and at the call of the chairperson or the State Forester.<sup>5</sup>

## **Duties and Authority**

The board supervises all matters of forest policy and management under the jurisdiction of this state.<sup>6</sup> The board must:<sup>7</sup>

- adopt rules to perform the functions defined by statute, including forest practice rules and the amount of civil penalties that may be imposed for particular violations;
- appoint a State Forester to be the chief executive officer of the State Forestry Department and who holds office at the pleasure of the board and acts as its secretary;
- provide general supervision of and direction to the State Forester;
- receive and adjudicate appeals of determinations by the State Forester;
- exercise overall responsibility for management of the Forest Resource Trust including administration of a voluntary loan program to finance establishment of stands of trees and the improved management of qualified private and local government forestlands;
- establish specified committees to assist the board in the administration of its statutory duties;
- provide for coordination with appropriate state and local agencies regarding procedures to be followed for review and comment on individual forest operations; and
- with the Department of State Lands, designate and set aside Common School Forest Lands.

The board may:<sup>8</sup>

- approve claims for expenses incurred under the statutes administered by the board;
- appoint advisory committees to make recommendations concerning any function vested by law in the board;
- acquire, hold, utilize, and dispose of land and real property by specified means, including the exercise of eminent domain and the sale of revenue bonds;
- go upon private property to determine the advisability or practicability of acquiring real property or any interest in real property;
- secure forest tree seedlings for the reforestation of forestlands and operate a state forest nursery to provide forest tree seedlings for the reforestation of forestland;
- in consultation with the Governor, direct the State Forester to facilitate the development of stewardship contracts utilizing private contractors and, when appropriate, to seek and

enter into a stewardship contract agreement with federal agencies to carry out forest management activities on federal lands;

- in consultation with the Governor, create a forum for interagency cooperation and collaborative public involvement regarding federal forest management issues that may include, at the discretion of the board, the appointment of advisory committees, the use of existing advisory committees, and procedures for holding public hearings;
- in consultation with the Governor, provide guidelines for the State Forestry Department and State Forester to follow that contain directions regarding the management of federal lands and that specify the goals and objectives of the board regarding the management of federal lands;
- in consultation with the Governor, participate, to the extent allowed by federal law, in the development of federal forest policies and the forest management planning processes of federal agencies;
- in consultation with the Governor, coordinate with the agencies of the executive department to assist the State Forestry Department;
- establish by rule specified programs as allowed by statute; and
- delegate specified appeals authority to an administrative law judge.
