

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 846 Program Change

SB 846 is the program change measure, and as amended, makes the necessary changes in statutes and session laws to support the 2091-21 legislatively approved budget, to clarify the application of statutes for the budget, and to modify provisions relating to the use of funds. SB 846 is a non-appropriation measure and is necessary to implement the budget rebalance plan for the 2019-21 biennium. The bill has an emergency clause and is effective on passage.

Specifically, the measure:

- Clarifies statutory language related to constitutional and statutory dedications of Lottery Funds;
- Repeals four reappropriations of Other Funds balances to the General Fund;
- Modifies the effective date from May 31 to June 30, 2021 of various transfers to the General Fund;
- Enables the expenditure of marijuana revenue established in Ballot Measure 110 on addiction treatment and recovery services;
- Establishes July 1, 2021 as the date the Ballot Measure 110 Oversight and Accountability Council has the authority to implement addiction recovery centers;
- Extends the deadline for the Oversight and Accountability Council adoption of administrative rules to September 1, 2021;
- Extends the deadline for the establishment of addiction recovery centers to January 1, 2022;
- Establishes the Summer Learning Program Account; and
- Directs the reversion of unexpended General Fund related to the Summer Learning Program.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 846 be amended by the –1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
