

**HB 3116 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY**

**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Directs the Department of Human Services to study and make recommendations for a more equitable funding structure for county-based community developmental disabilities programs and report to the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2022. Sunsets January 2, 2023. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Community Developmental Disability Programs are county-owned and operated programs that serve individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Community Developmental Disability Programs are reliant on state funding which in many counties does not account for the entirety of the workload model or serving clients who have barriers to service delivery due to cultural, linguistic, and socio-economic needs that are different from the dominant culture.

House Bill 3116 aims to restructure the funding model for community developmental disabilities programs in Oregon.
