Measure Description:

Directs the Public Utility Commission to investigate and make recommendations on the feasibility of expanding or increasing broadband internet access service, or other telecommunications services, pursuant to the Oregon Telephone Assistance Program, to an appropriate interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD), Public Utility Commission (PUC)

Analysis:
