WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Early Learning Division to develop plan to coordinate the provision of services to children from birth through age six. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Early Learning Division of the Oregon Department of Education was established by passage of House Bill 3234 in 2013. That measure transferred certain duties previously assigned to the Early Learning Council to the Division. Since that time, the Division has served to govern and manage most of the state's early care and education programs and services. House Bill 3334 requires the Division to develop a coordination plan for provision of services to children from birth through age six.
