**Measure Description:**

Directs Oregon Health Authority to study and make recommendations for improving coordination of youth mental health services among state agencies.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Human Services, Mental Health and Recovery to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The measure requires the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to study and make recommendations for improving the coordination of youth mental health services among state agencies. OHA is to submit a report on its findings to appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022.
