Measure Description:

Directs Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to establish publicly available database of certain information about misconduct and discipline of public safety employees established by department.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Counties, Oregon State Police (OSP), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA), Department of Corrections (DOC), Cities, District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Department of Justice (DOJ), Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary Subcommittee on Equitable Policing to the full House Committee on Judiciary.

The measure directs law enforcement units to report sanctions that they impose on officers to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) within 10 days of the discipline charge. The report must include the name and rank of the officer disciplined, the name of the unit at which the officer was employed, and a description of the circumstance of the discipline. DPSST is required to post that information to an existing database within 10 days of receiving it.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the full House Committee on Judiciary.
