

HB 2847 -2, -3 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs Office of Emergency Management to study and make recommendations regarding improvements to operations of office and submit report on its findings to Legislative Assembly by January 1, 2023.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-2 Replaces measure. Appropriates \$1,781,280 from General Fund to Oregon Military Department to fund nine additional positions in the Service Member and Family Support Program during biennium beginning July 1, 2021. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

REVENUE: *No revenue impact*

FISCAL: *Fiscal impact issued*

-3 Replaces measure. Appropriates \$791,680 from General Fund to Oregon Military Department to fund four additional positions in the Service Member and Family Support Program during biennium beginning July 1, 2021. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

The Oregon National Guard's Service Member and Family Support Program offers services in youth development, suicide prevention, financial counseling, reintegration, and transition.
