#### Measure Description:

Removes exception from regulation by Sexual Offense Treatment Board for certain persons.

### Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA)

### Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Judiciary and Ballot Measure 110 Implementation to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure removes the exception from regulation by the Sexual Offense Treatment Board for certain persons. The - 2 amendment makes this measure operative on May 31, 2022, and includes a blank General Fund appropriation for the Oregon Youth Authority (OYA).

Initial estimates from OYA are that this measure will cost \$675,391 General Fund in 2021-23, and \$955,734 General Fund in 2023-25, and require three new positions to implement. These numbers are estimates only until further analysis of the fiscal impact of this measure can be completed.

There is no fiscal impact anticipated for the Oregon Health Authority.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
