Measure Description:

Extends sunset for authorization to Department of Justice to assist victims of domestic violence and sexual assault with housing needs until January 2, 2024.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Housing and Community Services Department (HCSD), Department of Human Services (DHS), Department of Justice (DOJ)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure extends the sunset for authorization of Department of Justice to assist victims of domestic violence and sexual assault with housing needs.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on Housing and Community Services Department, Department of Human Services, and Department of Justice.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
