Measure Description:

Modifies procedures for early medical release of adult in custody from prison.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Department of Corrections (DOC), Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision (BPPPS), Criminal Justice Commission (CJC)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure modifies the process and requirements for the early release of an adult in custody (AIC) and specifies the medical conditions that may qualify AICs for early release. It establishes the Medical Release Advisory Committee within the State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision to provide recommendations for release and hear cases regarding early release. The bill specifies that the Department of Corrections (DOC) must help facilitate this early release application process as well as track certain early release data and report annually to the Legislative Assembly by December 31st each year. The measure is effective upon passage.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Further Analysis Required
