



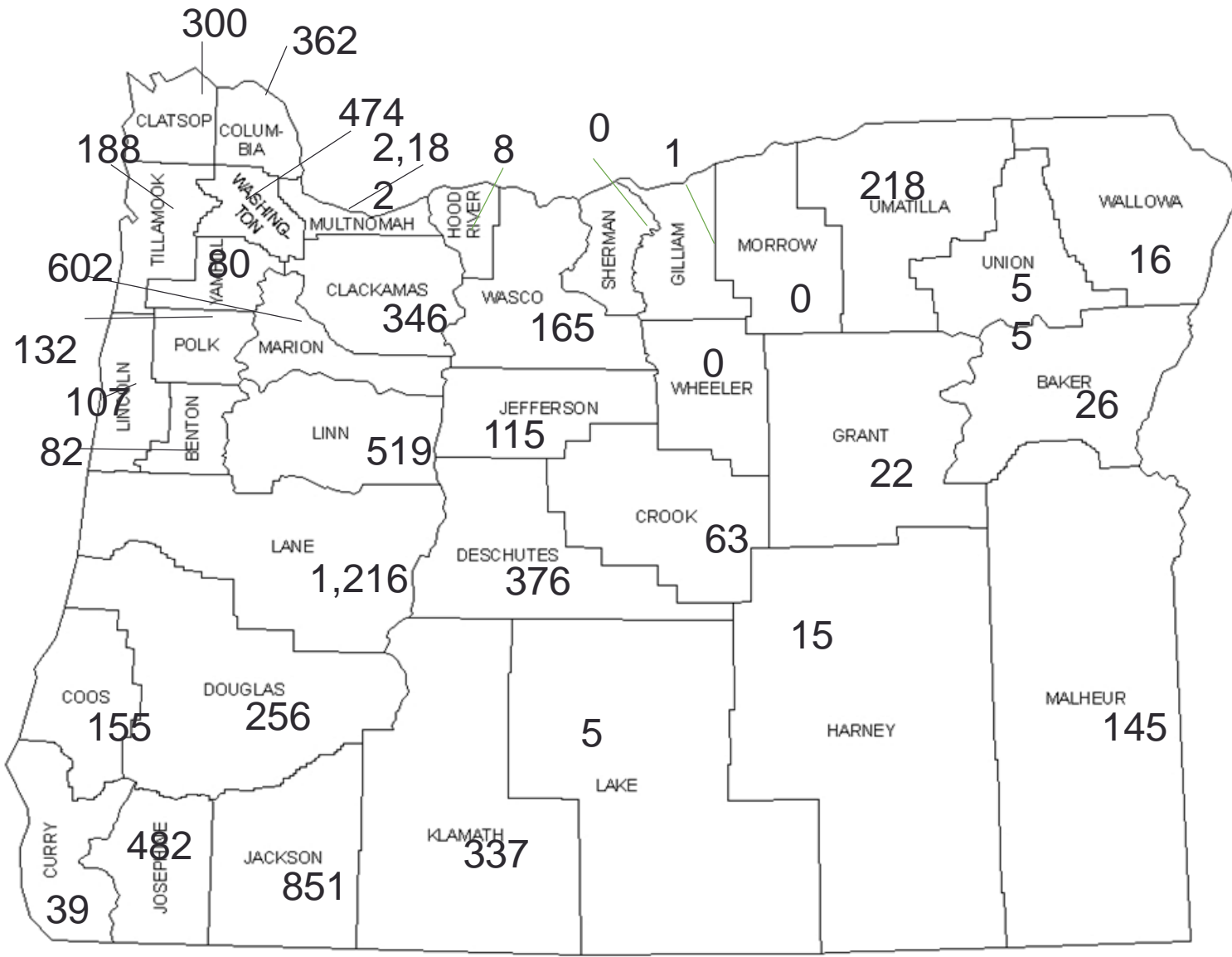

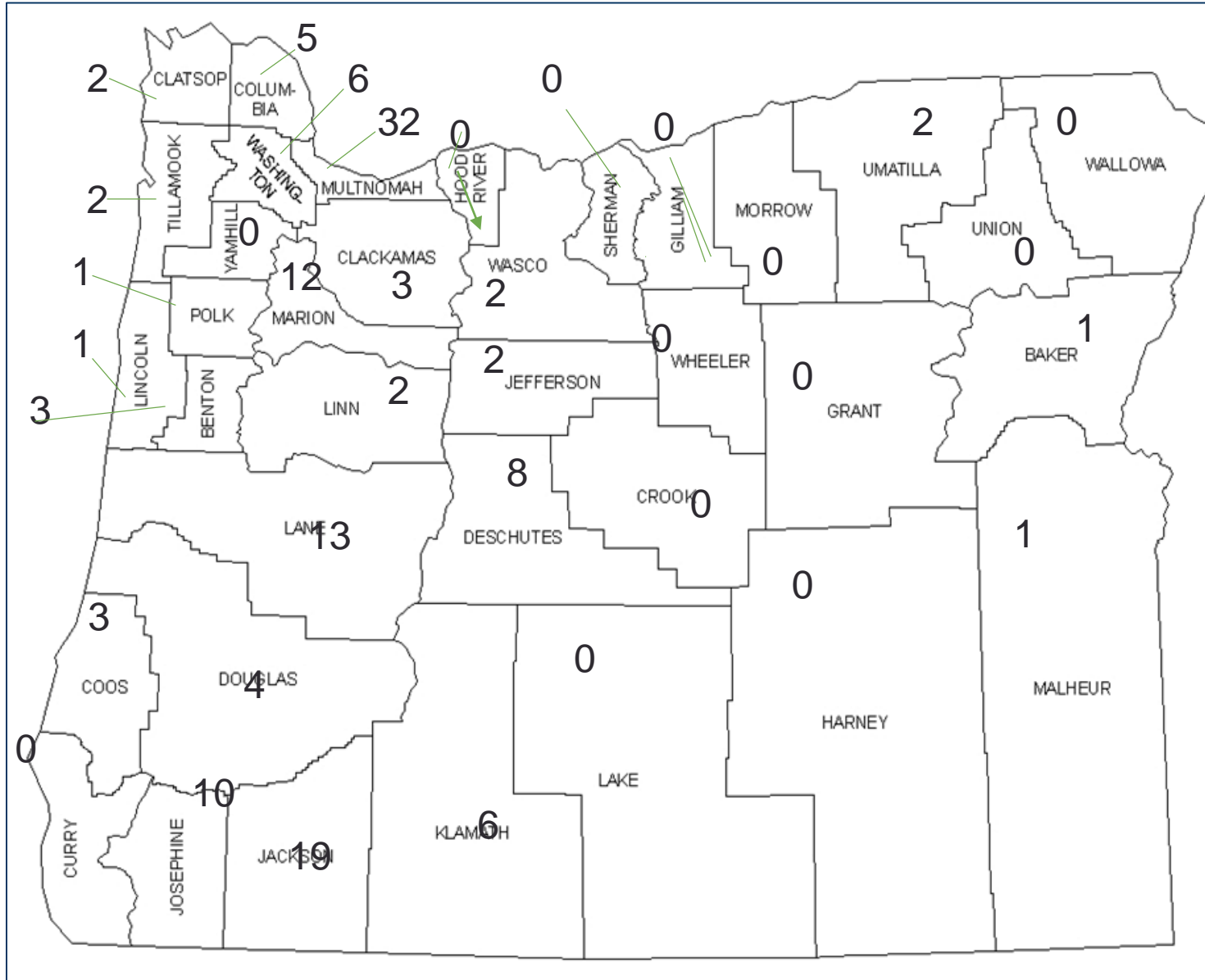

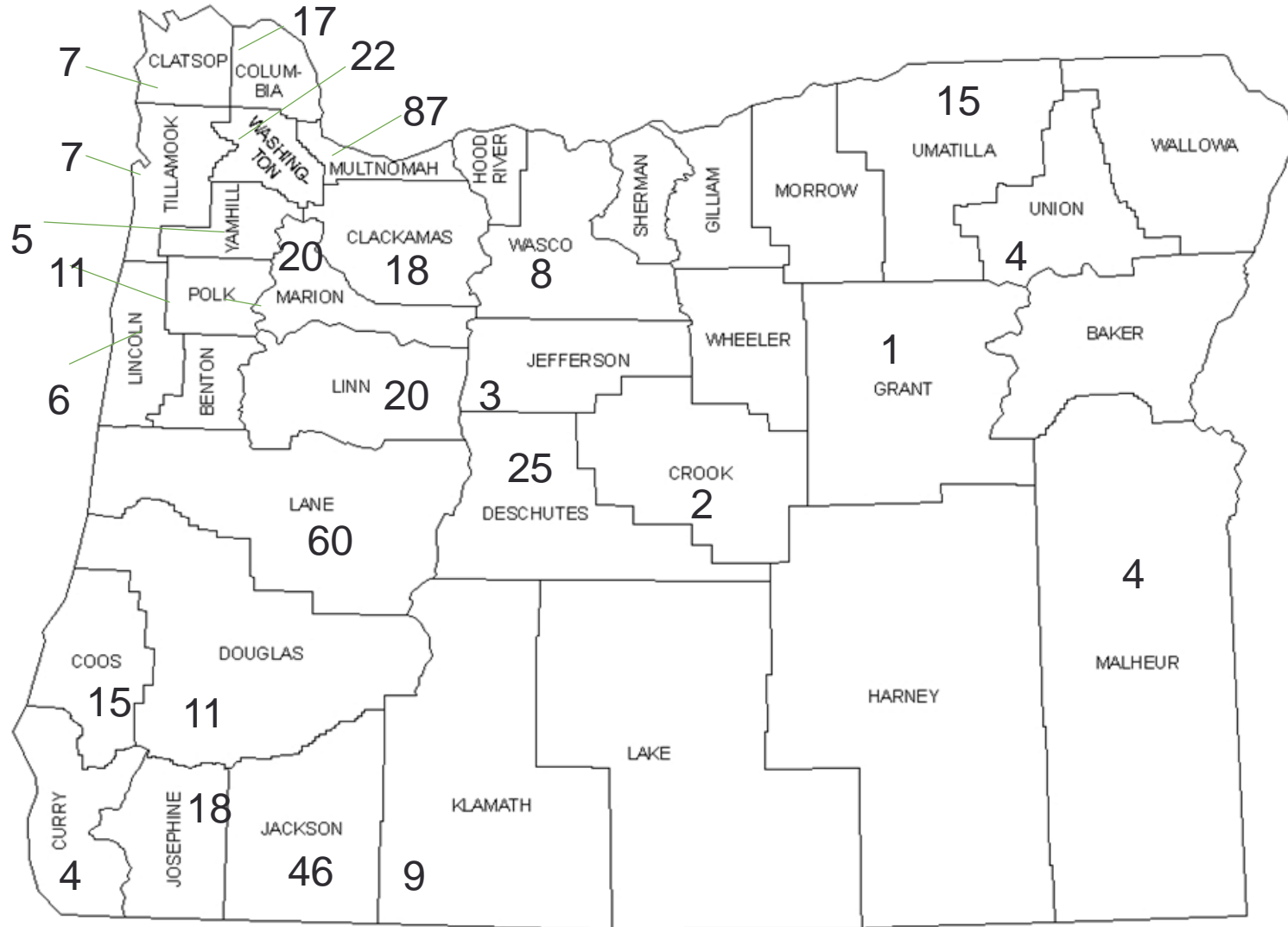

  - Not eligible due to age
  - PMDDT denied
  - Declined services
  - Receiving other benefits, VA

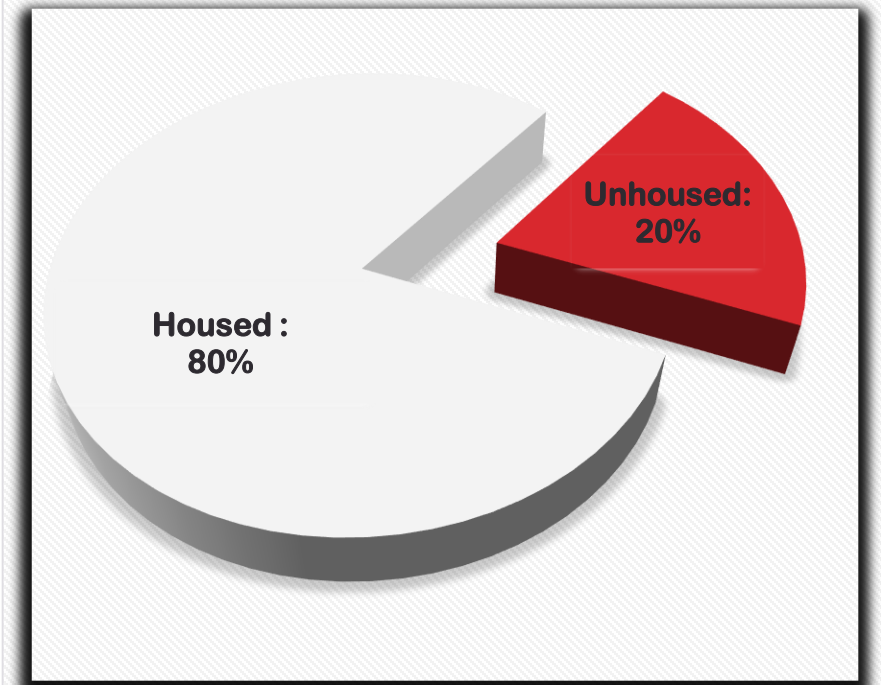

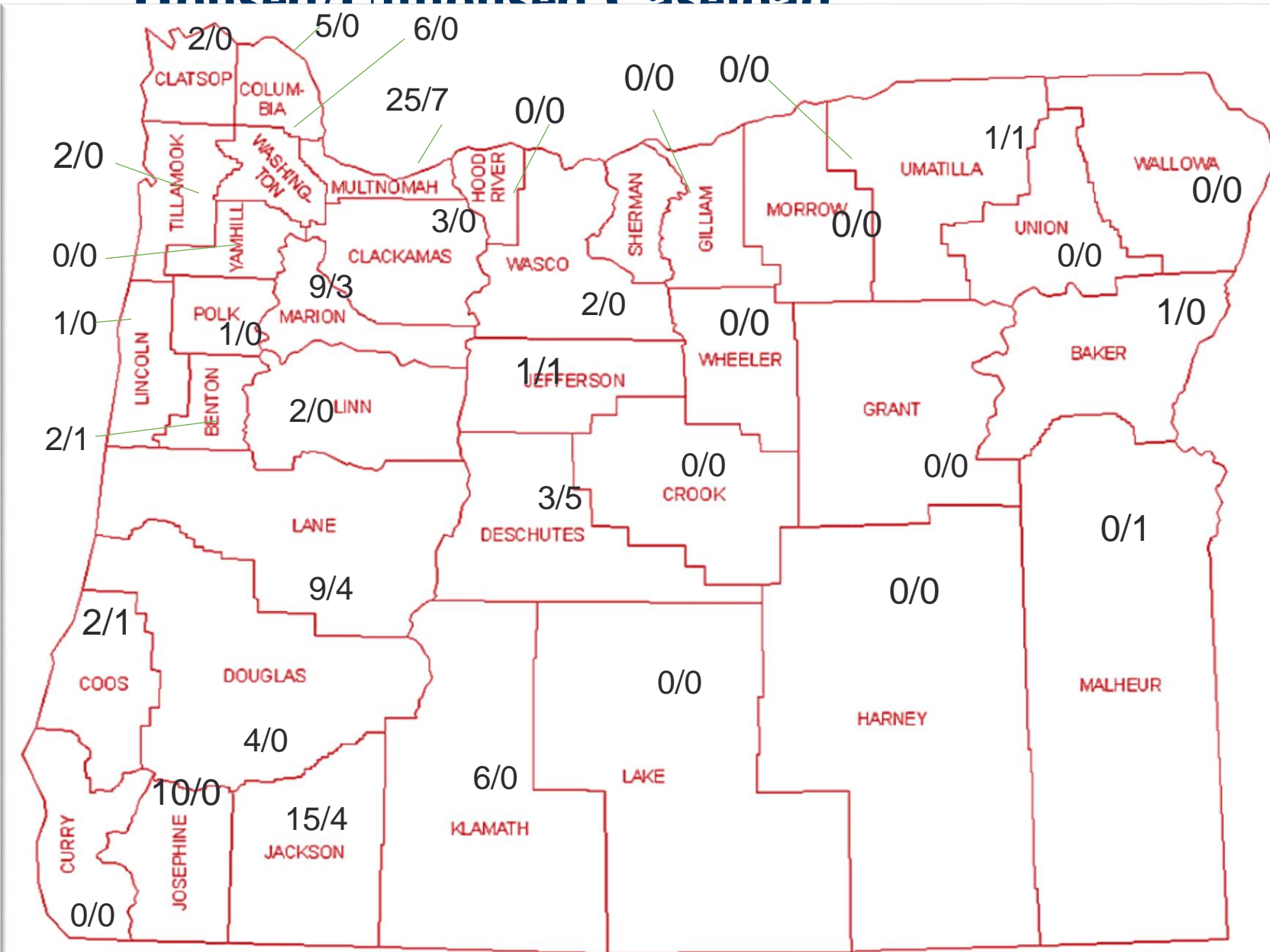

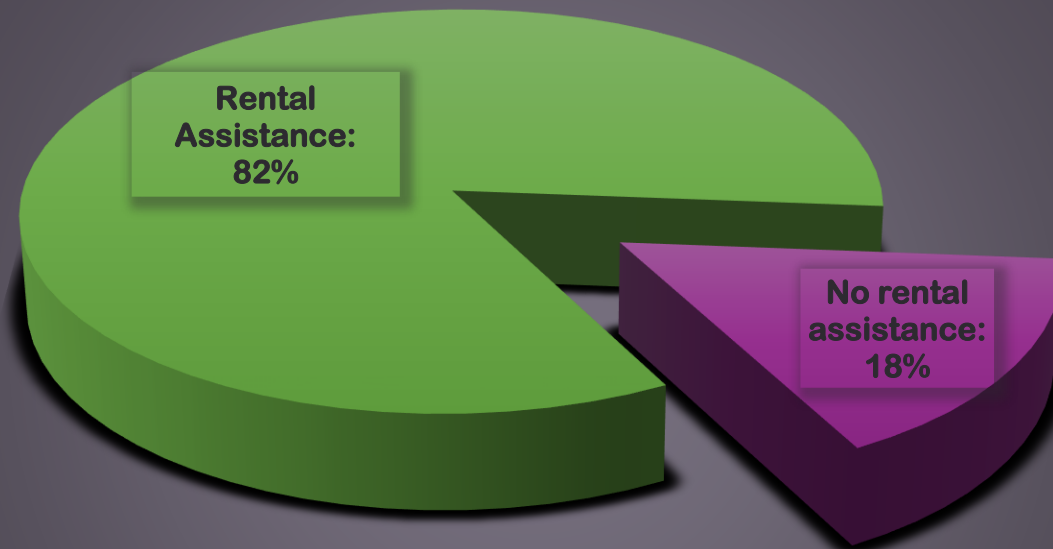

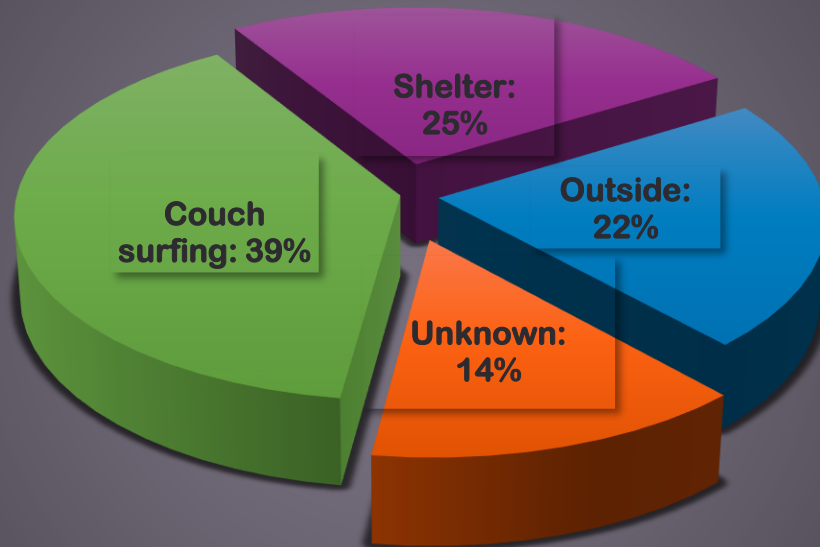

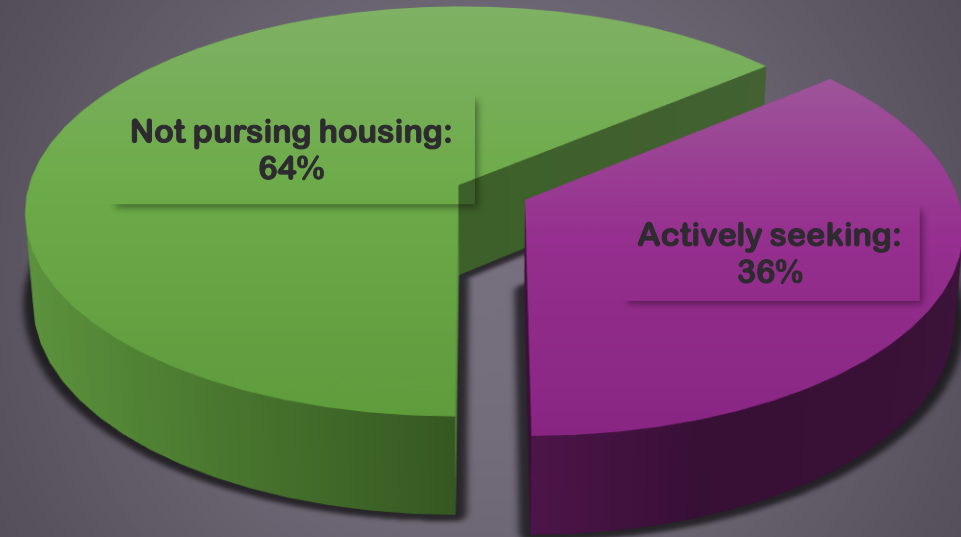
## A closer look at the unhoused population
