October 26, 2021 – Filing for primary election opens for major party candidates for Oregon Senate and House and U.S House if reapportionment plans adopted by Legislative Assembly were not challenged via the Oregon Supreme Court. (**SB 258-1:** Page 1, lines 10-13 and Page 2, lines 12-16) (**SB 259-2**, Page 8, lines 10-13 and Page 9, lines 3-7)

November 16, 2021 – Filing for primary election opens for major party candidates for Oregon Senate and House (but not U.S. House) if no redistricting plan was adopted by the Legislative Assembly, the Oregon Secretary of State (SOS) adopted a redistricting plan, and the SOS redistricting plan was not challenged via the Oregon Supreme Court. (SB 258-1: Page 1, lines 14-21) (SB 259-2: Page 8, lines 14-21)

<u>January 1 - February 8, 2022</u> – Dates between which filing will open for major party candidates for Oregon Senate or House or U.S. House if plans are challenged via the Oregon Supreme Court. The exact date the filing period will open will is dependent on when the challenged plans are finalized. (**SB 258-1:** Page 2, lines 1-7 and 17-22) (**SB 259-2:** Page 8, lines 22-28 and Page 9, lines 8-13)

March 8, 2022 – Deadline for Oregon Senate or House or U.S. House major party candidate to file for primary election. (**SB 258-1:** Page 1, lines 6-9 and Page 2, lines 8-11) (**SB 259-2:** Page 8, lines 6-9 and Page 2, lines 29-30 - Page 3, lines 1-2)

<u>March 10, 2022</u> – Deadline for Oregon Senate or House or U.S. House major party candidate to file statement and picture for voter's pamphlet. (**SB 258-1:** Page 2, lines 23-30 - Page 3, line 1) (**SB 259-2:** Page 9, lines 14-22)

<u>May 17, 2022</u> – Primary election day. (**SB 258-1**: Page 1, lines 4-5) (**SB 259-2**: Page 8, lines 4-5)
