Measure Description:

Creates credit against income taxes available to a taxpayer that is a seller of publicly supported housing in Oregon and makes a qualifying sale. Specifies credit amount as equal to _____ percent of the gain realized on the taxpayer's federal income tax return for the qualifying sale. Allows unused credit amount to be carried forward up to three succeeding tax years. Requires certification of tax credit by Housing and Community Services Department. Limits amount of credits certified to no more than three million per calendar year. Applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2022 and before January 1, 2028.
