#### Measure Description:

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to study state and local tax systems and report findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to revenue no later than September 15, 2022.

#### Government Unit(s) Affected:

Legislative Revenue Office (LRO)

#### Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Revenue to the Joint Committee on Tax Expenditures.

House Bill 2433 directs the Legislative Revenue Officer to study state and local tax systems and report the findings to interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to revenue by no later than September 15, 2022. The measure's substantive provisions are repealed on January 2, 2023. The measure takes effect 91 days after adjournment *sine die*.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Legislative Revenue Office.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Tax Expenditures.
