EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Employment Appeals Board subject to Senate confirmation.¹

ORS 657.685 (2019)

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Statutory Requirements³

The board consists of three members appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate.⁴ In the selection of the members, the Governor must give due consideration to the interests of labor, industry, and the public. Not more than two of the members may belong to the same political party (ALBA (D); HETTLE (N/A); **STEGER-BENTZ (D)**). The Governor must designate one of the members to serve as chairperson with duties and powers necessary for the performance of the function of the office as the Governor determines. In the event of an absence or as required by the workload, the chairperson may appoint, with the approval of the Governor, pro tempore members to serve for a period not to exceed 90 days. A majority of the Employment Appeals Board constitutes a quorum.

Duties and Authority

The board exists within the Employment Department to adjudicate appeals of decisions on eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits issued by an administrative law judge.⁵ The

board must, upon receipt of a timely application for review, promptly affirm, modify, or set aside the decision of the administrative law judge and notify interested parties of the decision:⁶

The board may:⁷

- reconsider any previous decision of the board;
- hold sessions any place within the state;
- administer oaths; and
- issue and serve, or by any sheriff, subpoenas for the attendance of employers or claimants and the production of papers, contracts, books, accounts, documents, and testimony.
