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## **Leading With Equity**

- Emphasis on communication with survivors in a linguistically and culturally appropriate way.
- Oregon provides shelter and food without regard to documentation status and directs these vulnerable survivors to communitybased organizations (CBOs) that are best suited to support their needs.



## **Current posture of sheltered households and efforts**

ODHS continues to provide shelter and meals to wildfire survivors, consistent with our mission to support people to become independent, healthy and safe.

- Provide shelter to survivors until they can return home.
- Find local affordable housing for people without homes.
- Move survivors who need longer term support from hotels into intermediate housing such as Fortify and RV camping locations.
- Provide disaster case management and wrap around services to support recovery.
- Contract with a CBO for to master lease Fortify properties and lease back to survivors.
