WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Changes name of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to “Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission.” Declares emergency, effective August 2, 2021.

House vote: Ayes, 54; Nays, 1--Zika; Excused, 4--Lively, Morgan, Smith G, Wallan

Minimal fiscal impact; no revenue impact

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Change of agency duties with passage of Ballot Measure 91 (2014)

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Following the passage of Measure 91 in 2014, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission was tasked with regulating the production, processing, and sale of recreational marijuana in Oregon through the Control, Regulation and Taxation of Marijuana and Industrial Hemp Act.

House Bill 2111 changes the name of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to the “Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission” reflecting the commission’s regulatory duties.
