Subject: HB 2746 – Relating to protective order information cards.
Work Session Recommendations

HB 2746 directs the Department of Justice (DOJ) to develop, implement, and administer a statewide Hope Card Program for the issuance of information cards regarding eligible civil protection orders.

A staff measure summary, fiscal impact statement, and revenue impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

There is a -A3 amendment to the measure that includes a General Fund appropriation to DOJ for the measure and which assumes the authorization of one permanent part-time Administrative Specialist-2 position (0.25 FTE). The 2023-25 biennial cost is estimated to be \$97,670 General Fund and one position (0.50 FTE).

Recommended Changes

The Legislative Fiscal Office recommends adoption of the -A3 amendment, which provides \$120,711 General Fund to the Department of Justice - Crime Victims and Survivor Services Division to implement the measure.

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that HB 2746, as amended by the -A3 amendment, to be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
