Measure Description:

Provides for the cancellation of outstanding real property taxes and interest on the taxes for real property, the ownership of which was transferred from the federal government to a port district, or for real property owned by a port district that does not have a working waterfront and has outstanding taxes owing since before 2012, for which the tax collector has exhausted all tax collection remedies.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Counties, Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Department of Revenue (DOR)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
