Subject: HB 2092 – Relating to youth programs
Work Session Recommendations

The measure directs the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to provide grants to local workforce development boards after allocating funds to Oregon Youth Corps. Requires HECC to allocate no less than 20 percent of program funds to organizations that serve communities of color and provides for minimum wage exemption for programs that are restricted under state or federal law.

The -A5 amendment removes Section 4 of the measure that provided a General Fund appropriation to HECC. The General Fund appropriation will be included in HECC's budget bill.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A5 amendment.

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that HB 2092, as amended by the -A5 amendment, to be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
