

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 2167 Relating to state entities

To: Ways and Means Full Committee

HB 2167 creates the Racial Justice Council within the Office of the Governor. The council will consist of the Governor, as chairperson, and no more than 40 additional members appointed by the Governor. The Governor will establish committees to address policies of interest to the council and appoint each council member to at least one committee.

Funding to pay the cost of the positions necessary to staff the Council is included in SB 5520, the budget bill for the Office of the Governor.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends HB 2167 be reported out do pass.
