

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 755

Relating to substance use

SB 755 amends the Drug Addiction Treatment and Recovery Act, which was enacted through the approval of Ballot Measure 110 during the November 2020 general election. The bill is the outcome of work done in the Senate Committee on Judiciary and Ballot Measure 110 Implementation to determine the adjustments necessary to implement the new law with respect to criminal and court procedures for individuals found in the possession of small amounts of controlled substances. The bill also adds oversight and transparency requirements for the allocation of funding to Behavioral Health Resource Networks and other grantees for addiction treatment and recovery services.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 755 be amended by the -A37 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
