

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 96 Relating to cannabis

SB 96 authorizes the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to regulate the testing and labeling of inhalant delivery systems containing industrial hemp-derived vapor items that are sold in Oregon.

The Oregon Health Authority must establish testing standards, and the Oregon Department of Agriculture and OLCC may impose civil penalties against anyone who violates provisions of this measure.

The fiscal impact of the measure to OLCC is incorporated in HB 5018, the agency's budget bill.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends SB 96 be reported out do pass.
