## SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

## HB 3294 Relating to feminine hygiene products in public schools

HB 3294 requires school districts, charter schools, Education Service Districts, community colleges, and public universities to stock menstrual products in two student bathrooms in each facility for the first year of the biennium and every bathroom in the second year.

The Other Funds in this program are a distribution or carve-out from the State School Fund and identified as Grants-in-Aid for the Oregon Department of Education. The measure transfers \$5,595,000 from the State School Fund to be used for Grant-in-Aids and appropriates \$137,483 General Fund to the Department of Education to administer the program. The costs associated with public universities and community colleges are expected to be paid out of the respective support funds.

The Education Subcommittee recommends HB 3294 be amended by the -A4 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
