HB 3354 requires the Teachers Standards and Practices Commission to create a performance-based measure to determine if a licensing candidate's knowledge, skills and compensation qualify the candidate for a license. It would replace the current measures used by Education Preparation Programs. In addition, the measure requires TSPC to lower artificial barriers presented by standardized tests and evaluate locally adopted assessment measures.

The Education Subcommittee recommends HB 3354 be amended by the -A5 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
