HB 2928 Relating to the use of tools by law enforcement agencies

HB 2928 regulates and limits the use of chemical incapacitants, kinetic impact projectiles, strobe lights, and sound devices by law enforcement for the purpose of crowd control, and requires that certain accommodations and instructions be made by law enforcement when deploying specified devices. Amendments to this measure removed the prohibition on the use of strobe lights, clarified exceptions to the prohibition on using chemical incapacitants for crowd control by law enforcement, and appropriated \$605,781 General Fund to the Department of State Police to implement the provisions of the bill.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends HB 2928 be amended by the –A17 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
