**Measure Description:**

Establishes Public Drinking Water and Sewer Ratepayer Assistance Fund.

**Revenue Impact:**

There is no revenue impact.

**Impact Explanation:**

The measure allows collection of funds for low-income electric bill payment and crisis assistance. While these collections may result in an increase in fees and rates passed on to electric customers throughout the state, these fees are not taxes either imposed by the state and local government, nor collected by the government. In addition, the determination and collection of these fees by the electric company is subject to the regulatory process of the Public Utility Commission.
